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General Instructions

This document contains important information and must be kept for future reference.

Please read thoroughly before commencing assembly and use of your Redsbaby Jive. Incorrect assembly and use can be dangerous and result in serious injury or even death.

There may be slight variations in the design of your product to that shown in the images of this instruction manual.

Warranty information

12 Month Warranty

The Redsbaby Jive and its accessories come with a 12 Month Warranty to cover against faults in materials and workmanship when your products are used under normal conditions, according to our user manuals and technical specifications.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

The 12 Month Warranty period starts from the date your product(s) are dispatched from our warehouse. This includes products that are purchased via pre-sale (for example items that are out of stock or newly launching products). Please remember that for a claim to be valid, it must be made within the claims period.

There are a few circumstances under which the warranty is not valid including:

- defects resulting from improper care or use;
- normal wear and tear, including scratches to the pram frame;
- products that are purchased second hand or from an unauthorised distributor;
- faulty or incorrect assembly;
- using a part or accessory that is not compatible with the product and/or not manufactured by Redsbaby;
- tyre punctures; and
- damage to handlebar grips or fabrics as a result of normal handling and daily use.

How To Make A Warranty Claim

Send an email to info@redsbaby.com.au to notify us of your warranty claim. To validate your warranty claim we will require you to include in your email:

- a description of the warranty defect including photographs;
- your contact details;
- attached invoice with order number; and
- product batch number (the batch number is printed on a sticker that is located at the bottom of your pram frame, near the brake).

We will respond to your warranty claim within 7 business days and depending on the nature of the warranty claim, arrange collection of the product from your nominated address. Collection will take place on a business day (i.e. not a public holiday or weekend within your state or territory) between 7am and 5.30pm. Please take care to repack the product in secure and stable packaging to avoid any damage occurring in the returns transit. We do not take responsibility for any damage that occurs in transit to and from our pram repairer.

Once our pram repairer has received the product they will inspect and confirm the reported defect. We will then contact you with further information surrounding the repair such as the estimated turn around time.

Warnings and safety precautions

Please read the following warnings and safety precautions thoroughly before using your Redsbaby Jive. Incorrect assembly and use can result in serious injury or death.

Always follow safety instructions for assembly, folding and use.

Always ensure that your Redsbaby Jive is correctly assembled and locks are engaged before use.

After unpacking, immediately discard any plastic wrapping and packaging materials, as these can lead to a choking hazard.

Always use the safety features that come with your Redsbaby Jive, such as the tether strap, brakes and harness.

GENERAL WARNINGS:

- To avoid injury or death: Always apply the brakes whenever the Redsbaby Jive is stationary.
- Do not leave children unattended.
- Secure the child in the harness at all times.
- Do not carry extra children or bags on the Redsbaby Jive.
- Make sure children are clear of any moving parts if you adjust the Redsbaby Jive, otherwise they may be injured.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- Put on all the brakes whenever you park the Redsbaby Jive.
- Use the harness at all times.
- When not in use disconnect shoulder straps from the waist strap and/or buckle.
- The harness can form loops which may cause a strangulation hazard. Never leave a harness connected when not fitted to a child in the Redsbaby Jive.
- Use the tether strap to stop the Redsbaby Jive rolling away.
- Do not use the seat or bassinet with any other models of stroller.
- Do not use bassinet once the child can sit up unaided.
- Only use the bassinet in the flat position. Do not recline.
- Do not use any accessories that are not designed for or compatible with the Redsbaby Jive.

- Take care when used on stairs or escalators.
- Do not use or leave the Redsbaby Jive near open fire or exposed flame.
- Brakes must always be applied when the Redsbaby Jive is not moving.

GENERAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- When the vehicle is being folded and unfolded, there is potential for fingers or parts of the body to be injured and due care should be exercised.
- Overloading, incorrect folding or the use of non-approved accessories may cause injury or damage your Redsbaby Jive.
- Ensure you follow the regular maintenance and care instructions included in this manual. Pay special attention to maintenance and care of the brakes.
- The Redsbaby Jive must only be used for one (1) child.
- Do not hang bags on the Redsbaby Jive handles, as this can cause it to become unstable.
- Do not lift or carry the Redsbaby Jive when a child is in it.
- Do not lift or carry the Redsbaby Jive when fully assembled. Only lift and carry when folded.
- The Redsbaby Jive is designed for use on flat or gentle sloping surfaces and may be unstable on higher sloping and uneven surfaces. The vehicle may tip over when used incorrectly on steep inclines/declines.
- Do not leave the rain cover on without the ventilation window on the front of the rain cover open.
- When using your Redsbaby Jive on stairs or escalators, take care.

MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMITS:

- Maximum weight for a child in the bassinet is 9kg (19.8 lbs).
- Maximum weight for a child in the seat is 20kg (44.1 lbs).
- Maximum weight for items in the basket is 5kg (11 lbs).

Assembly instructions

Frame

To release the frame from the folded position:

1. Place frame on the ground and position yourself behind the handle bar.
2. Release the automatic frame lock located on the left hand side of the frame.
3. Holding the frame on both sides, gently lift the frame continuing until the frame locks into place. When the frame has been fully opened, you will hear and feel a firm 'click'.



Brake component

The brake will come permanently assembled on your pram frame and is located at the bottom of the frame in the right hand side and is red in colour.

Rear wheels

Fit the rear wheels by clicking them into rear wheel housing located at the back of the pram frame. You will hear and feel a firm 'click' when the wheels are locked in place.

IMPORTANT: Ensure you check that the wheels are clicked in correctly by tugging them outwards. Failure to attach the wheels correctly will result in them falling off the pram while in use.

To remove, simply press the button in the middle of the wheel to release.

Front swivel wheels

Fit the front swivel wheels by inserting them into the front wheel housing located at the front of the frame. You will hear and feel a firm 'click' when the wheels are locked in place.

Assembling the bassinet

Note: The Jive Bassinet will come in a separate carton to your Jive pram.

WARNING:

- Do not use bassinet once the child can sit up unaided.
- This bassinet is only approved for use with model Redsbaby Jive.
- The maximum weight of a child that can be carried in this bassinet: 9kgs.

1. Pull the three support rods located in the bottom of the bassinet into place by following step 1A, 2A and 3A below. Once assembled correctly, your bassinet will sit rigid and upright.



2. Assemble the bassinet lining on the bassinet frame.
 3. Insert your bassinet mattress into the bottom of the bassinet snugly.
 4. Secure your bassinet apron by using the press studs located on the bassinet canopy.
- TIP!** You can open the apron using the zippers rather than unbuttoning the apron from the canopy each time.
5. Secure the bassinet adaptors in the pram frame.
 6. Click the bassinet into the adaptors. Check the bassinet is secured by lifting it upwards when in the pram frame.
 7. To remove, lift and release the locks on either side of the bassinet.

Assembling the seat and bumper

WARNING:

- Do not use this seat with any other models of stroller.
- This seat is only approved for use with model: Redsbaby Jive.
- The maximum weight of a child that can be carried in this seat: 20kgs.

1. Take the seat unit fabric and stretch the head rest section over the top of the circular frame and secure the Velcro tab located at the back.
2. Pull the rest of the seat unit fabric tightly towards the bottom of the frame. Secure the seat unit fabric to the frame using the press studs provided down the left and right hand sides of the circle frame.
3. Pull the foot rest upwards and secure the bottom of the seat unit fabric over the foot rest and attach the Velcro tab located under the foot rest.
4. Attach the bumper by aligning the ends of the bumper with the two openings on the circular frame. Gently push down into place until you hear and feel a firm 'click' on both sides.
5. If desired, attach the canopy.
6. To place the seat on the frame, push down gently until you feel and hear a firm 'click'.

Basket

WARNING:

- The weight limit of items in the shopping basket is 5kg.
- Do not exceed the weight limit. Overloading the shopping basket may result in damage to the basket and your stroller.

1. Secure the basket to the frame using the press studs provided.
2. Loop the webbing located at the rear of the basket around the frame, and fasten using the press studs provided. Repeat using the webbing located on the left and right sides of the basket by securing to the side of the pram frame.

To remove, release all press studs.

Using your Redsbaby Jive

Folding and unfolding the Redsbaby Jive frame



WARNING:

- Make sure children are clear of any moving parts when you adjust the Redsbaby Jive, otherwise they may be injured.
- Ensure the frame fold locks are engaged correctly before placing a child in the Redsbaby Jive.

To release the frame from the folded position:

1. Release the the frame fold lock on the left hand side of the frame.
2. Holding the frame on either side, gently lift the top half of the frame and place on the ground.
3. Continue to lift the handle until the frame fold locks engage.

IMPORTANT: When the frame fold locks have been engaged correctly and the frame has been fully opened, you will hear and feel a firm 'click'.

To fold the frame

1. Remove the bassinet or seat unit if attached to the frame.
2. Simultaneously pull back on the frame fold locks on the left and right hand side of the frame.
3. Gently fold the frame forwards and downwards until the frame fold latches automatically engage.

Note: The frame fold latch will engage automatically.

4. Turn the handle bar inwards by pressing the buttons located on either side simultaneously.

Tip: You can also fold the Redsbaby Jive with the seat connected in the fully upright and forward-facing position.

Safe lifting and carrying of the Redsbaby Jive frame when folded

IMPORTANT: Do not lift or carry the Redsbaby Jive when a child is in it.

IMPORTANT: Do not lift or carry the Redsbaby Jive when fully assembled. Only lift and carry when folded.

1. Always lift and carry the frame using two hands.
2. Ensure the frame fold locks are engaged.

Engaging and releasing the brake

The brake is located next to the right rear wheel of the Redsbaby Jive. The brake is identified by its red colour.

1. To engage the brake, press downwards and backwards on the brake until you feel and hear a 'click'.
2. To release the brake, press your foot forwards on the brake in the opposite direction until the brake lock disengages.

IMPORTANT: Ensure you have disengaged the brake completely before pushing your pram. If you hear a clicking sound, double check the brake lock isn't clicking on the rear wheel. It can be helpful to push your heel downwards on the brake in the released position firmly to ensure the brake lock is not touching the rear wheel.

Locking the front swivel wheels

1. Press downwards on the buttons located on top for the front wheel housing until you hear and feel a 'click'.
2. Push the Redsbaby Jive forwards until you hear a second click in both front wheels.
2. To unlock, simply press the buttons again. When released successfully, you will hear and feel a 'click'.

Adjusting the handle

Simultaneously press the buttons located on either side of the handle and move the handle to the desired height.

Using the 5-point safety harness

WARNING:

- Use the harness at all times.
- When not in use disconnect shoulder straps from the waist strap and/or buckle. The harness can form loops which may cause a strangulation hazard. Never leave a harness connected when not fitted to a child in the Redsbaby Jive.

IMPORTANT: For the safety of your child the 5-point safety harness must be properly fitted and adjusted. Follow the instructions and Figure 1 below.

1. Ensure the seat is assembled correctly by following steps on page 11.
2. Slide the shoulder strap clip (A1) onto the waist strap clip (B1) and clip into the center buckle (C).
3. Slide the shoulder strap clip (A2) onto the waist strap clip (B2) and clip into the center buckle (C)

Note: The shoulder heights can be adjusted according to your child's height by feeding the shoulder straps through the seat back. The shoulder straps should sit just above the shoulders of your child.

4. Adjust the shoulder strap (A1) and (A2), waist straps (B1) and (B2) and crotch strap (D) to the desired fit.
5. To unlock the 5-point safety harness, simply press the button in the middle of the centre buckle (C) to release all straps at once.

Note: Padding has been provided for the shoulder straps (A1) and (A2) and crotch strap (D) for the comfort of your child. The use of this padding is optional.

Reversing and reclining the seat

IMPORTANT: Do not reverse or recline the seat when a child is in the seat.

1. To recline, press and hold both round buttons on the inside of the seat and move into the desired position. When in place, you will hear and feel a firm 'click'.
2. To reverse, remove the seat unit by pulling the tabs located on either side of the seat unit inwards and lift upwards. The seat unit can be fitted either rear or forward facing.

Using the tether strap



WARNING:

- Use the tether strap to stop the Redsbaby Jive rolling away.

Attach the tether strap to your wrist at all times when using the Redsbaby Jive.

Lifting and carrying the Redsbaby Jive safely

IMPORTANT: Do not lift or carry the Redsbaby Jive when a child is in it.

IMPORTANT: Do not lift or carry the Redsbaby Jive when fully assembled. Only lift and carry when folded. For folding instructions, refer to page 12.

Product care

IMPORTANT: Ensure you follow the regular maintenance and care instructions. Pay special attention to maintenance and care of the brakes.

General Maintenance

- Regularly inspect the locking devices, brakes, harness assembly, catches, seat adjusters, joints and fixings to ensure they are secure and in full working order.
- ***Do not store your Redsbaby Jive in your car boot for prolonged periods of time, especially when it is hot and this can lead to warping some of the plastics parts and reduce the life of your product.***
- The brakes and wheels are subject to wear and should be replaced as and when necessary. Brakes are available through contacting our customer care team at info@redsbaby.com.au.
- Should any parts of the Redsbaby Jive become stiff or difficult to operate, ensure that dirt is not the cause. Use a light application of a silicone spray lubricant, ensuring the lubricant penetrates between the components. Use sparingly, as excessive application may encourage the accumulation of dirt. Regular light lubrication of moving parts will extend the life of your Redsbaby Jive and make operating, opening and folding much easier.
- Do not leave the Redsbaby Jive in sunlight for prolonged periods of time, as the colour of some fabrics may fade.
- Store the Redsbaby Jive in a dry, well-ventilated and safe place.
- Do not use your Redsbaby Jive if any screws are loose or missing or if any component is damaged.

Cleaning

Plastic and metal parts

- Sponge clean with warm water and a mild detergent and then air dry.
- Do not use any abrasive or corrosive cleaning products on your Redsbaby Jive.

Fabrics

- May be cleaned by sponging lightly with warm water and a mild soap (ensure your child is not allergic to the soap you use). Then air dry.
- For more instructions, follow the care labels on each fabric item.

IMPORTANT: Do not place any fabric or other component of your Redsbaby Jive in the dryer. Allow all parts to dry thoroughly before storing.
