HOW TO CLEAN PAD

Machine wash in warm water

- DO NOT USE BLEACH
- DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER
- Lay flat to dry completely before re-assembling onto the product.


DIRT CUP & FILTER: REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT

IMPORTANT: FOR BEST RESULTS, CLEAN THE FILTER AFTER EACH USE.

NOTE: For best performance, replace filter at least every 3-6 months depending on the level of use. If filter is discoloured or damaged it requires replacement.



Press the dirt cup release button located above the cup on the body of the unit (Diagram 1).

Tip the dirt cup out to remove (Diagram 1a).



Grasp the center tab on the filter and pull out of dirt cup.



Empty Contents into bin. For best results, shake and lightly tap filter against bin to remove remaining dirt.

REPLACEMENT



Return filter to dirt cup.



Tilt and push dirt cup in until it locks into place.


CLEAN AND RINSE FILTER



Hold filter under running water to rinse.

NOT use soap/ detergent.

Tap excess water out of filter.





To reattach dirt cup: Align bottom first and pivot dirt cup until it snaps into place.



- 3. Always unplug the vacuum cleaner before emptying dirt container and removing/reinserting filter and/or SWIPES pad.
- 4. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 5. This appliance is not intended for use by children and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- 6. Cleaning and maintenance shall not be made by children.
- 7. The appliance should only be used as described in this user guide.
- 8. Only Dirt Devil recommended consumables should be used with this appliance.
- 9. Do not use this vacuum cleaner if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or dropped into water. Do not use this vacuum cleaner with a damaged charger.
- 10. Do not pull or carry charger by the cord. Do not use the cord as a handle, close a door on the cord or pull the cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run the vacuum cleaner over the cord. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- 11. Do not handle the charger or the vacuum cleaner with wet hands.




HOW TO ASSEMBLE

CHARGING






NOTE: The indicator light will come on to indicate that the appliance is charging. It will go off when charging has been completed.

STORAGE




Use the storage hook to hang Vac anywhere.


FOR BEST RESULTS, USE DIRT DEVIL DRY SWIPES MICROFIBRE PADS.



Slide one side in pocket and then the other.



Use the Dirt Devil microfibre cloths to pick up fine debris like dirt, dust and pet hair. Use vacuum to suck up any left over debris. For best results, wash the microfibre cloth after every use.



To turn vac on: Press and release the vac power button located in the handle. To turn vac off: Press and release the vac power button again.
